

Pollination Station

Each circle represents the center of a flower. When a bee forages they go to the same kind of flowers. Draw some petals on each of the circles; make sure they are the same type of flower. Next, put some cheese puffs in the center of the flowers.

Then just like bees collect them for food, you can eat them. Make your fingers walk around the flowers like a bee would land on them. Don't lick your fingers. When you are finished you will see how the powdery cheese transferred to your fingers and then to different flowers. When bees pollinate pollen sticks to their legs and hairy bodies and then to different flowers.
